When confronted with the facelessness of plastic as a material, the Kooij collection seeks to generate warmth and familiarity through experimental processes.

The Boulder technique has been developed to foster unmanipulated, spontaneous patterning in recycled plastic.

# KO OJ

The leg of a Boulder table follows the same principal, as ribbons of colour wrap around a basic mould.

Boulder tables are made from recycled fridge interiors sourced from The Netherlands, France, and Belgium. This material is naturally off-white and and imbued with chalk--an additive which imparts a soft, marble-esque tactility to the plastic.

To this base we add a tonal melange of oxide-based pigment. Please consult us for the most updated colour options--which are an ongoing cause for play and experimentation!
